

Town of Dracut Conservation Land Use Permit Application

Please review the official Regulations for the Use of Conservation Land in Dracut to determine if your activity requires permission from the Conservation Commission.

There is no permit fee, but donations are appreciated.

Permit applications should be submitted 30 days in advance of the intended use in case a meeting with the Conservation Commission needs to be scheduled. However, staff will make every effort to review permits during business hours even if submitted on short notice. Written permits need to be in the possession of the applicant during use of the property. Permits can be revoked if regulations or special conditions are not followed. Permits are only valid for the approved dates indicated. Signed copies of the permit will be given to the applicant and the Dracut Police.

The Dracut Conservation Commission reserves the right to refuse any uses that are potentially damaging to the conservation values of our open space. The Town of Dracut and Dracut Conservation Commission cannot assume any liability for injuries or damage to users' property while on Town Conservation Lands; persons entering thereon do so at their own risk.
