

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE RECIPROCAL PROGRAM 2023

The Town of Dracut is pleased to provide a number of options for residents to safely dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW). Thank you to those who participated in our HHW collection event held at the Dillon Center on March 11, 2023. In addition, and in cooperation with the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, we have entered into a reciprocal arrangement with a number of other communities that allows residents of each town to participate in multiple household hazardous waste collection events.

If you are a **Dracut resident**, this means you also have the opportunity to participate in a partner town's collection event.

Residents from Partner Towns – thank you for your commitment to disposing of HHW responsibly. Please review the information on registering for our partner communities HHW collection events.

Registration: See Reciprocal HHW Events schedule link below for information (e.g. some communities require pre-registration).

Payment: These events are open to Dracut residents on a fee-basis. If you don't live in Dracut but attend our event, you will be asked for payment at our event based on the amount of material you bring. Please bring the appropriate form of payment (e.g. check) indicated in the Notes column of the schedule. Pricing is based on the host town's specific contract and will be determined by the contractor. As an example, some contractors charge \$32 for the first 12 gallons (liquid or dry equivalent) or \$53 for 12 – 25 gallons.

Identification: You will be asked to show identification (e.g., driver's license) confirming your residency.
